**Damage to the Facilities**

**Theft or Damage to Personal Property**

I acknowledge that the McKenna Children's Museum does not accept responsibility for theft, loss or damage to personal property; or for theft, loss or damage to automobiles or personal property left in the parking lot. The McKenna Children's Museum suggests that Members do not bring valuables on the premises.

**Emergency Medical Aid**

The McKenna Children's Museum reserves the right to call emergency medical aid for an injured Member or guest and said Member or guest accepts responsibility for any financial obligations arising from such emergency medical aid or transportation to a medical facility.

**Amending of Rules**

I understand the McKenna Children's Museum reserves the right to amend or add to these conditions and to adopt new conditions as it may deem necessary for the proper management of the business, and I agree to abide and conform to any such changes.

**Unavailability of Facility or Services**

I agree to accept the fact that a particular facility or service in the premises may be unavailable at any particular time due to mechanical breakdown, fire, Act of God, condemnation, catastrophe, or any other reason. Further, I agree not to hold the McKenna Children's Museum responsible or liable for such occurrences.

**Release from Liability**

I agree, in attending and using the facilities and exhibits therein, that I do so at my own risk. The McKenna Children's Museum shall not be held liable for any damages arising from personal injuries sustained by me and/or my guest(s) in, on, or about the premises. I assume full responsibility for any injuries or damages which may occur to me in, on, or about the premises, and I do hereby fully and forever release and discharge the McKenna Children's Museum and all associate owners, employees, and agents from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights or action or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my use or intended use of said facilities and exhibits thereof.

All caregivers are to be 16 years of age or older and present a valid driver's license as proof of age/identification. For the safety of all visitors, we gladly provide adults unaccompanied by children a guided tour of the Museum. Clean-up is an important part of "play." Please help you children to keep components in their designated area. Inside voices only and refrain from running. Shoes and shirt must be worn at all times.

As used herein, the McKenna Children's Museum means its successors, assigns, employees, officers, directors, shareholders, and all persons, corporations, partnerships, and other entities with which it is or may in the future become affiliated.

McKenna Children's Museum memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.

McKenna Children's Museum memberships are not valid during school field trips.
